TAX COLLECTION - EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 13, 2020, THE CLERK'S OFFICE IS CLOSED AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. This decision occurred after Executive Order #94 was issued by Governor Evers.

PLEASE MAIL YOUR TAX INSTALLMENT STUB AND CHECK BY JANUARY 31, 2021. If you would like a receipt, please send a Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope. No postdated checks will be accepted.

Dog and Cat Licenses: Please mail Check, proof of current Rabies Vaccination form (not the receipt from the vet), with name, sex and color of dog, and a Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope. Tags will not be mailed if the Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope is not enclosed.

Dogs: Neutered \$10.00, Not Neutered \$15.00 **Cats:** Spayed \$8.00, Not Spayed \$13.00.

Message from the Mayor... The 2021 Budget - To maintain the high quality of services to our citizens, we worked together as a team to achieve a balanced budget. The 2021 tax levy is \$359,798 and the mill rate will be \$5.84 per thousand dollars of property value; residential property valued at \$50,000 would have an approximate increase of \$1.00 over prior year.

Police Department... Winter Parking: Will remain in effect thru April 15th from midnight until 8:00 A.M. During this time, you must park on the side of the street that correlates to the calendar date. On odd number days, you must park on the side of the street with odd numbered addresses. On even number days, you must park on the street with even numbered addresses.

If a snow emergency is declared, there is no parking on any City street until the end of the Emergency. If your vehicle is on the street it may be towed at your expense. We ask that everyone does their part to help ensure safe travel throughout the City of Adams as we enter the winter season. Public Works Publication... Snow & Ice From Sidewalks:

Within forty-eight (48) hours after the snow or ice ends, it shall be the duty of the owners and/or the occupants of any lot or parcel of land in the City of Adams to remove, or cause to be removed, the snow from any and all sidewalks and the nearest cross-side-walks adjacent to the premises of such owner(s) or occupant(s), and to keep the same free and clear of snow and ice for the full width of the sidewalk.

Also, a reminder please keep the alleys clear of vehicles, garbage cans, basketball hoops, etc. and that it is the property owner's responsibility to keep their mailboxes cleared during the winter months for postal delivery. As a courtesy to our fire department, if you have a fire hydrant on your property, please keep it cleared as well. Thank you.
