

## Aldermanic Districts

Following the 2020 Census, City Council approved new ward and aldermanic district boundaries in response to the latest census data.

The City's aldermanic district boundaries were modified so the population in each district would have as close to equal as practical. The redistricting also had to take County Supervisory boundaries into consideration.
